RESPONSIBILITIES

Work across residential programs, providing individual and group counseling. Complete paperwork in accordance with regulations. Maintain quality clinical records utilizing agency electronic health record. Develop and assess treatment plans and progress towards measurable goals. Work closely with clients to engage them in decision-making processes regarding their treatment and recovery. Plan/implement aftercare for clients leaving the program. Provide clients and/or family members with SUD information and make appropriate referrals. Collaborate with community service providers to meet client needs. Assist with shift coverage of residential services when necessary. Must be self-directed and flexible in order to meet the needs of clients, administration, and management. At times, certain situations may arise that extend beyond the limits of your job description. With the support of management, you will be expected to work through these situations promptly, efficiently, and within the guidelines of the appropriate policy.

QUALIFICATIONS

Preferred Bachelor's degree in Social Work, Psychology, Counseling, or related field plus one year of experience in a clinical setting. CASAC preferred or must be willing to work towards CASAC status. Ability to demonstrate understanding of various counseling modalities and philosophies for the treatment of SUD. Experience with EHR system a plus.
