GRANTS TO BENEFIT HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS (GBHI) GRANT/PROJECT COORDINATOR

RESPONSIBILITIES

The successful candidate will be responsible for coordinating the activities of the 5-year Grants to Benefit Homeless Individuals grant. Duties include:

- Overseeing daily implementation of the grant and ensuring adherence to the project narrative, timeline, and budget.
- Establishing processes and protocols for and coordinating implementation of the major grant activities/supportive services to identify people with substance use disorder who are homeless and coordinate obtainment of permanent housing and linkage to services and activities supportive of recovery.
- Tracking grant spending in collaboration with the Director of Project Innovation, and Expansion, Director of Residential, and Finance Department.
- Monitoring grant progress, supporting data collection and ongoing evaluation, and writing and submitting timely federal reports and continuation applications. Leading timely collection and submission of GPRA/SPARS data as required by SAMHSA.
- Supporting enhancing services for homeless individuals with SUD, including assisting with establishment of new housing opportunities if funds allow.
- Assisting with writing and/or revising relevant policies and procedures.
- Providing case management services for participants.
- Transporting project participants occasionally/as needed.
- Supervising staff if and as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

A Bachelor's degree is preferred, Associate's degree required as well as demonstrated leadership or project coordination experience, excellent writing and speaking skills, and outstanding collaborative skills. CASACs and other Qualified Health Professionals (QHP) are encouraged to apply. Experienced Case Managers and/or Peers encouraged to apply. Case Management experience preferred. Grant implementation and reporting experience preferred.

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

This position is under the supervision of the Director of Recovery Services and will need to be able to collaborate with Treatment and Residential program leaders.

Status: Full time based on a 35-hour work week. This is a grant funded position.
