RESPONSIBILITIES

Maintain and clean work area and follow food safety procedures. Wash dishes, pots, and pans. Stack dishes, glasses, and silverware. Remove trash. Set up and maintain food items, check appropriate temperature of food, oversee food storage and food handling practices to maintain the areas according to safe food handling regulations. Assist with training/supervising assigned clients in the food service area. Know how to safely operate and properly clean machines/appliances in kitchen. Accurately follow recipes as necessary and serve food in a friendly and helpful manner.

QUALIFICATIONS

High school diploma/GED, food service experience preferred. The position has some physical demands such as ability to bend, stoop, kneel, crouch and twist. Ability to stand for prolonged periods if necessary. Ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds on a regular basis. Must be able to walk up and down stairs. Must be available afternoons, evenings, weekends. Basic computer skills in word processing, e-mail, and Internet use.
