Provide helpful, supportive suggestions to clients regarding issues of transportation. Transport clients/consumers to treatment and other program activities and appointments as necessary. Complete purchase orders as necessary for purchase of gas or otherwise for the vehicle. Assist Fleet Coordinator in maintenance of vehicles, scheduling appts., etc. Meet with the supervisor on a weekly basis (or as needed) for supervision. Flexible hours required.
